WILDLIFE ART SHOW**  
September 29 to October 28, 2005

**ELIGIBILITY:**

Open To all artists 21 years and older living in the Dallas/Fort Worth metropolitan area.

**WORK ELIGIBILITY:**

All entry subject matter must be wildlife creatures. All work must be original.

Categories include:

1. Oil, acrylic on canvas and pastel paintings.
2. Water media on paper
3. Mixed Media, collage, drawings and hand-pulled graphics (no photographs or computer-generated art)

**FRAMING:**

Artwork must be framed and wired with screw eyes ready to hang. All works on paper must be under Plexiglas glazing, except for pastels, which may be under glass. 1.5" deep wrap around canvas may be submitted, no staples showing and painted on all sides. Size limit of all works is 40" X 40".

**SELECTION AND AWARDS:** each artist may enter up to three works. Juror will select:

<b>Best of Show</b>	\$500
<b>First Place</b>	\$300
<b>Second Place</b>	\$200
<b>Third Place</b>	\$100
<b>Emerging Artist Award</b>	\$ 50

(Given to an artist with three years or less experience)

**Masters Award** \$ 50

(Given to an artist who is a previous winner in the IAA Hippo Fantasia Wildlife Art Show)

**Honorable Mentions at the discretion of the Juror. Prizes at the discretion of IAA.**

**Artist must be present or represented to accept awards.**

4. October 9 (2PM to 4PM) **Reception and Awards Ceremony. Artist must be present or be represented to accept awards.**
5. October 28 (10AM to 6PM) **Show closes: Pick up your artwork**

All sales must be arranged between the artist and buyer.
