WILDLIFE ART SHOW
September 29 to October 27, 2006**

ELIGIBILITY:

Open To all artists 18 and older.

WORK ELIGIBILITY:

All entry subject matter must be wildlife creatures. No domestic pets. All work must be original and painted within the last two years.

Categories include:

1. Oil, acrylic on canvas and pastel paintings.
2. Water media
3. Mixed Media, collage drawings and hand-pulled graphics

(No photographs or computer-generated art)

FRAMING:

Artwork must be framed and wired with screw eyes or D rings ready to hang. No saw tooth hangers accepted. All works on paper must be under Plexiglas glazing if over 18"x24", except for pastels, which may be under glass. 1.5" deep wrap around canvas may be submitted, no staples showing and painted on all sides. Size limit of all works is 40" X 40".

SELECTION AND AWARDS: each artist may enter up to **three works**. Juror will select:

Third Place	\$100

(3)Honorable Mentions, each	\$ 50

JUROR: ROBIN INGLE

Robin is a native Texan who began her artistic career when handed her first Crayola. From that point on she has grown into a nationally known artist. 3. October 1 (1PM to 6PM) and October 2 (10AM to 2PM) – **Pick up works juried out of the show at the Center for the Arts at Jaycee Park.**
4. October 8 (2PM to 4PM) **Reception and Awards Ceremony at Center for the Arts at Jaycee Park. Artists must be present to receive an award or must have a representative accept in their place. All winners will be notified in advance of awards ceremony.**
5. October 27 (10AM to 6PM) **Show closes: Pick up your artwork at Center for the Arts.**

SALES:

All sales must be arranged between the artist and buyer. A commission of 10% for members and 20% for non-members will go to IAA.
